Only Nebraska players may compete in this event. The top player in each section will be the 2012 Nebraska Individual Scholastic Chess Champion. The top finisher in the K-12 section, enrolled in grades 9-12, will be the Nebraska qualifier for the Denker Tournament of High School State Champions. The top finisher in the K-8 section, enrolled in grades K-8, will be the Nebraska qualifier for the Barber K-8 Tournament of State Champions. Players enrolled this spring in any Nebraska school or who are home schooled are eligible.

Announcements on the day of the tournament take precedence over this flyer.

On site registration is from 8:00 to 8:45 a.m. ONLY players who have check-ed by 8:45 will be paired for round 1. Opening announcements will be held 5 minutes before the first round starts. –Round 1 for K-12 starts at 9:00; Round 1 for K-8 starts at 9:10; Round 1 for K-6 starts at 9:20; and Round 1 for K-3 starts at 9:30. Subsequent rounds will start approximately 10 minutes after completion of the prior round. Lunch breaks will be announced. Help is wanted, Please notify Gary Marks if you can lend a hand.

Tie Break Announcement: Tie Breaks for all sections will be 1. Common game; 2. Modified Median; 3. Solkoff; 4. Cumulative; and 5. Cumulative opposition.

K-12: Open to K-12th grade – 4 rounds Swiss, Game 60 (if enough players, 5th rd, G 45). Trophies to Champion, 2nd, 3rd, 1st and 2nd under 1000/unr.

K-8: Open to K-8th grade – 4 rounds Swiss, Game 60 60 (if enough players, 5th rd, G 45). Trophies to Champion, 2nd, 3rd, 1st and 2nd under 800/unr.

K-6: Open to K-6 grade – 5 rounds Swiss, Game 45 Trophies to Champion, 2nd, 3rd, 1st and 2nd under 600/unr.

K-3: Open to K-3 grade – 5 rounds Swiss, Game 30 Trophies to Champion, 2nd, 3rd, 1st and 2nd under 400/unr.

USCF membership is required for all sections except for K-3 Primary section. USCF membership is required for K-3 players who have previously been a USCF member. Memberships available onsite.

Please bring chess sets and clocks, some limited availability onsite.

Entry fee is \$15 **if received by** February 21, 2012. On site entry fee is \$20.
